NURSING EDUCATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

SUBJECT: Progression of Students from First BSN Nursing Class to Graduation

PURPOSES/OBJECTIVES: To assure that all students complete curriculum requirements for graduation as anticipated.

POLICY:

Students will obtain feedback on their progress in meeting graduation requirements in a timely manner.

PROCEDURE:

1. Students must meet with an academic advisor before registration in the first term of study, and thereafter pursuant to college policy. Advisors will check the curriculum advising sheets and discuss a plan of study for the student and/or problem identification.
2. An academic plan can be viewed on Watermark formally known as Aviso. Or a copy can be found in the student chart.
3. Students will be notified when to apply for graduation. It is the responsibility of the student to apply for graduation by the given deadline.
4. A minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in all courses required in the nursing curriculum.
5. A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in order to retain a seat in nursing and progress to the next class.
6. There will be no changes in policies for student progression or completion of the program for students currently enrolled in the program.
7. NUR 4800 Nursing Capstone must be the final course for the student to graduate. This course cannot be taken with any other NUR 3000 or NUR 4000 level courses unless prior approval from the director.
