**NURSING EDUCATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE**

SUBJECT: Progression of Students from current BSN Nursing Class to Next BSN Nursing Class

- PURPOSES/OBJECTIVES:
1. To assure that all students have an opportunity to obtain feedback on meeting clinical objectives.
  2. To assure all students comprehend what is required to successfully progress to the next level.
- 

POLICY:

Students will obtain feedback on their progress in clinical competencies as listed on the clinical evaluation tool and understand how to progress to the next class.

PROCEDURE:

1. The student must attain a satisfactory grade as stated on the course syllabus.
2. If a student is unsatisfactory in clinical and/or lab the student will receive a grade of "D" for the course.
3. Students must attain a C or better in the same theory portion of the nursing course.
4. A minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in all courses required in the nursing curriculum.
5. A minimum GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in order to retain a seat in nursing and progress to the next class.
