Certification

Students who complete MTC's Phlebotomy certificate program are eligible to sit for the certification exam offered by the American Society of Clinical Pathologists (ASCP, 33 West Monroe, Suite 1600, Chicago, IL 60603, 312-541-4999, www.ascp.org). The credential awarded upon successful completion of the exam is PBT (ASCP).

Admission

Limited Enrollment

To apply for acceptance into the Medical Sciences Phlebotomy certificate program, your application file should contain:

1. MTC Application for Admission and nonrefundable application fee.
2. Final high school transcript (or GED results) and college transcripts (if applicable).
3. Minimum accumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 in high school or college-level coursework (whichever is most recent).
4. Minimum of four (4) hours of phlebotomy observation documented by a completed "Observation Validation Form."
5. Completed Phlebotomy program application.

If required, College foundation courses are available to help you meet any specialized program admission requirements.
