Admission Requirements:

- Possess a high school diploma or GED
- Have committed no felonies or serious misdemeanors.
- Pass a physical assessment (see OPOTC Basic Training Physical Assessment Form attached)
- Possess an Ohio driver's license

Admission Procedure:

1. Apply to Marion Technical College
 - a. Meet with an MTC admission counselor.
 - b. Submit the MTC Application for Admission to the Office of Admissions.
 - c. Complete the reading and writing portions of the Basic Skills Assessment (COMPASS) with placement into English Composition (ENG1090A) or completion of foundation courses.
 - d. Submit an official copy of high school transcript or GED results.

2. First interview with the Marion Law Enforcement Academy.
 Contact Dan Arledge at 740-389-4636 ext. 251 to schedule an interview to submit this one-page application.

3. Students who meet the above requirements will receive the Marion Law Enforcement Academy Application Packet which includes:
 - a. Passing all three parts of the physical assessment test (push-ups, sit-ups, and a 1.5 mile run)
 - b. Completion of OPOTA forms including a Request for National Webcheck®
 - c. Interview with the Marion Law Enforcement Academy Commander to turn in completed packet. Deadline: October 29, 2010.
