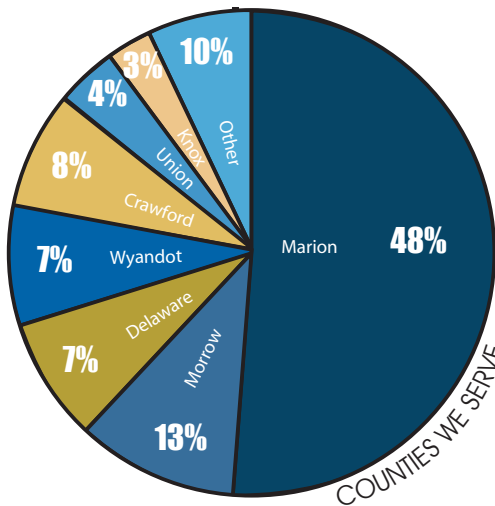
FUN FACTS
