## MARION TECHNICAL COLLEGE LIFE EXPERIENCE CREDIT PROCEDURE

Life Experience Credit is an option of recognizing prior knowledge and hands-on experience relative to the student's field of study as a substitute for required coursework. The student must provide documentation of demonstrating college-level competency obtained through an occupational experience and/or job training (minimum 3 pages/maximum 5 pages).

#### **ELIGIBLILITY:**

- 1. A student is eligible for Life Experience (LE) Credit if they:
  - Are not currently enrolled in the course
  - Have not previously taken or replaced a grade for the course
  - Have not previously attempted a credit-by-exam for the course
  - Have a 2.0 minimum grade point average and are registered for at least one other course at Marion Technical College (MTC)

#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

- 2. The student will submit the following to the Dean of the specified technology:
  - The completed Request for Life Experience Credit form with receipt number from the Business Office (non-refundable \$15 per course credit hour).
  - A report
    - The report must identify how a previous occupational experience relates directly to the competencies the student would have learned by completing the specified course. (See course syllabus for course competencies.).
    - The report must be typed in essay format and include:
      - Description of job
      - Routine responsibilities-daily, weekly, monthly
      - Special projects
      - Description of environment-type of business, personnel, and equipment/software
  - Documentation of credentials, including:
    - Resume outlining:
      - Employment
        - Place of employment
        - Dates of employment
        - Position title
        - Responsibilities
        - Education
        - Training
        - Job description
        - Statement from employer/supervisor outlining job responsibilities
      - Education history
        - Documentation of degrees or certificates of completion
        - Documentation of awards or recognition
        - Portfolio containing examples of work
- 3. Based on documentation provided, the Dean will approve or deny the *Request for Life Experience Credit*. The student will receive notification from the Office of the Registrar.

### **CREDIT AWARDED:**

If the application for life experience has been approved by the Dean, the Request for Life Experience Credit will be applied. The credit hours earned will fill elective requirements and/or serve as a course substitution on an approval basis. A maximum of 48 credits hours earned through life experience and/or credit-by-examination may be applied toward an associate degree.
