NURSING EDUCATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

SUBJECT: Progression of Students from First Nursing Class to Graduation

PURPOSES/OBJECTIVES: To assure that all students complete curriculum requirements for graduation as anticipated.

POLICY:

Students will obtain feedback on their progress in meeting graduation requirements in a timely manner.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Students must meet with an academic advisor before registration in the first term of study, and thereafter pursuant to college policy. Advisors will check the curriculum advising sheets and discuss a plan of study for the student and/or problem identification.
- 2. An academic plan will be signed by second year students before the end of fall/spring term prior to graduation and placed in the student file. Any courses to be completed for graduation in the academic plan are the responsibility of the student to complete in order to graduate.
- 3. A minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in all courses required in the nursing curriculum.
- 4. A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in order to retain a seat in nursing and progress to the next class.
- 5. There will be no changes in policies for student progression or completion of the program for students currently enrolled in the program.
