## NURSING EDUCATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

SUBJECT: Progression of Students from Nursing Class to Next Nursing Class		
PURPOSES/OBJECTIVES:	1.	To assure that all students have an opportunity to obtain feedback on meeting clinical objectives.
	2.	To assure all students comprehend what is required to successfully progress to the next level.

SUD IFOT: Descression of Students from Naming Class to Next Naming Class

## POLICY:

Students will obtain feedback on their progress in clinical competencies as listed on the clinical evaluation tool and understand how to progress to the next class.

## PROCEDURE:

- 1. Students may be given written midterm and final evaluations by the instructors using the clinical evaluation tool. This tool is used to determine areas of strength, weakness, and progression in the clinical area.
- 2. The student must attain a satisfactory grade as stated on the course syllabus/clinical evaluation tool at the end of the clinical experience.
- 3. The clinical evaluation tool will be reviewed by the student and instructor at midterm and the end of the module/academic term. In reviewing the form, the student does not indicate agreement with the information, only that the student has read the information provided. The student is invited to write comments on the form. If a student is unsatisfactory in clinical the student will receive a grade of "D" for the course.
- 4. Students will complete a written or electronic self-evaluation as directed by their instructors. The self-evaluation will then be attached to the clinical evaluation tool.
- 5. Every student will meet on an individual basis with the clinical instructor at the time of evaluation.
- 6. Completed and signed clinical evaluation forms are to be submitted by the date that final grades are due each term.
- 7. In addition, students must attain a C or better in the same theory portion of the nursing course.
- 8. A minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in all courses required in the nursing curriculum.
- 9. A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in order to retain a seat in nursing and progress to the next class.
