## **Program Directors and staff,**

As we reported to you in an email sent in December, 2013, at its November 2013 meeting CAPTE changed its Rules to include the expectation that, effective July 1, 2014, accredited programs will display the CAPTE logo supplied by the Accreditation Department on the program web site, though it may also be placed on other program or institution webpages where reference is made to accreditation of the program by CAPTE. This logo will indicate that CAPTE has accredited the program. See section 8.20(a) of CAPTE Rules of Practice and Procedure.

The supplied logo will be protected from use by non-approved parties and will allow users on the program web site to obtain immediate verification of accreditation, as well as additional relevant information, including CAPTE contact information, by clicking on the logo. Use of the logo will allow programs to remove CAPTE's contact information from the program's webpage as currently required.

Activating these features requires implementation of the logo on the program webpage as outlined in this guide.

To facilitate this process and provide assistance as needed, CAPTE has partnered with the technology company Yoshki. Telephone and e-mail technical support information is on page two of this guide. If you have questions about the logo or requirements not related to technical implementation, please contact CAPTE staff.


## Website Validation

Yoshki's website validation technology is a simple but important feature for the CAPTE online logo.

In basic terms, anyone browsing your website can now click the CAPTE logo and receive an instant confirmation of the program's accreditation status.

When a visitor clicks on the CAPTE logo they will be seamlessly directed to a page on the CAPTE website which will instantly validate the accreditation status.

Following this check, your visitor will then be presented with the message below confirming that the program is accredited by CAPTE. Once this is complete your visitor will be returned back to your website straight away.
