NURSING EDUCATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

SUBJECT: Progression of Students from current BSN Nursing Class to Next BSN Nursing Class

PURPOSES/OBJECTIVES: 1. To assure that all students have an opportunity to obtain feedback on meeting clinical objectives.

2. To assure all students comprehend what is required to successfully progress to the next level.

POLICY:

Students will obtain feedback on their progress in clinical competencies as listed on the clinical evaluation tool and understand how to progress to the next class.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The student must attain a satisfactory grade as stated on the course syllabus.
- 2. If a student is unsatisfactory in clinical and/or lab the student will receive a grade of "D" for the course.
- 3. Students must attain a C or better in the same theory portion of the nursing course.
- 4. A minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in all courses required in the nursing curriculum.
- 5. A minimum GPA of 2.0 must be maintained in order to retain a seat in nursing and progress to the next class.

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
