## **THE STUDENT AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Student Ambassador Scholarship Program is designed to award high-achieving, current Marion Technical College students with scholarships of up to \$1,000 (up to, but not exceeding, the student's cost of attendance). In return, those students selected will serve approximately 50 hours per semester as a Student Ambassador of MTC.

In this role they will assist the Office of Enrollment Services by: providing campus tours to prospective students and their families; assist with social media presence for MTC; recruitment event preparation and attendance; Marion Campus event help; representing MTC at occasional off-campus events such as community parades and career fairs; other duties as assigned.

In conjunction with the financial assistance this program provides, it will also develop students' leadership and professional skill by facilitating their active engagement with campus events and activities.

To apply for this scholarship program, applicants must meet the minimum requirements listed below:

### *Minimum Requirements*

- 3.0+ cumulative GPA at the time of submitting the Ambassador Application
- Be enrolled for at least 6 credit hours per semester throughout the year
- Current FAFSA on file with Financial Aid Office
- Must have a positive attitude about MTC
- Must have a willingness to interact with the general public in promotion of MTC
- Must have a willingness to work in teams for event planning and promotion.
- Be able to commit to morning or afternoon events
- Be experienced with social media applications such as Facebook, Instagram, X
- Understands that approximately 50 hours of service is expected per semester
