

2016 FAFSA Completion Workshops – coming in February!

The Ohio State University, Marion Technical College and the I Can Center of Excellence will hold our annual FAFSA Completion Workshops for the 2016-17 award year. These **FREE** financial aid sessions are open to the public. All are welcome regardless of their college choice.

This is an opportunity to fill out the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) with assistance. Research indicates that completion of this document is one of the most important factors in predicting a student's chance to attend college. The FAFSA is required to determine eligibility for most types of federal student aid including, but not limited to, federal (*PELL*) and state grants, work study programs, some scholarships, and subsidized & unsubsidized student loans.

2015 tax returns do not need to be completed to attend the FAFSA Completion Workshop sessions. We can estimate using income amounts for 2014 or your 2015 federal tax returns.

These sessions will be held on the second floor of the Marion Campus Library Classroom Building in the computer lab. Staff from the Ohio State Marion, Marion Technical College and the I CAN Center of Excellence will be available to assist students and families.

Bring all of the following documents which pertain to you, your spouse and/or your parents for the FAFSA Completion session:

- Income amounts: 2015 federal tax returns, W-2 forms and any applicable income tax documents (2014 federal tax returns do not need to be completed and filed in order to attend.)
- A listing of any other types of untaxed income or benefits received in 2015 -- may include:
- Documentation from you and/or your parent's case worker with the total amount of TANF received for 2015
- Supplemental Social Security Disability received in 2015
- The total amount of child support paid and/or received in 2015
- The total amount of Federal Work Study received in 2015
- Bank statements
- Investment records
- Social Security number
- FSA ID – If you haven't logged in to a Federal Student Aid site (such as fafsa.gov or StudentLoans.gov) since May 10 2015, you will need to create an FSA ID before you can log on in the future
