Federal Work Study (FWS)

This program allows students with demonstrated financial need, enrolled at least half time, to earn money at an on campus or off campus job to help pay for their educational expenses. Tutoring, mentoring and community service positions are also available. Part-time employment averaging 10-20 hours week is available for students on this program.

The FWS is awarded to the student by the Financial Aid Office. A student would have to have financial need remaining prior to awarding FWS to qualify for consideration. The actual award is subject to other aid already obtained by the student. The maximum allowable earnings under the FWS at MTC is dependent upon the unmet need of the student.

Every year, MTC meets the requirements for spending 7% on community service.

The monitoring of awards is done by the Financial Aid Director. Quarterly reports are used to compare awards and earnings. Increasing awards is done on a case-by-case basis.

FWS is offered on a first-come, first serve basis based on positions available.
