The Ohio Police Officer Training Academy is located at Marion Tech Downtown. The classes are taught by award-winning instructor Greg Perry. Perry is the commander of MTC's Law Enforcement Academy and Director of Criminal Justice and Law. This Morrow County resident has devoted himself to helping law enforcement officers become better officers and basic training cadets to become strong officers. Students who successfully complete the Marion Technical College Peace Officer Basic Training Academy will earn 30 college credits. The college credits may be applied toward an MTC Associate of Technical Studies degree or some of the credits may be applied toward an MTC Associate of Applied Science in Criminal Justice degree. Upon successful completion of all Academy requirements, students will be eligible to take the OPOTC certification exam and become an Ohio peace officer. Perry's students have a 100% passage rate on the state exam.
