Senator Bill Reineke at MTC Downtown



Senator Bill Reineke was the guest speaker at the October monthly Manufacturing Careers Connections meeting. He talked about wanting to continue to build relationships between business and education and help students find their "purpose". He discussed S.B. 166 – which he calls the Student Purpose Bill – designed to help students get into high-paying careers within a skills pathway. It allows student-workers as young as 15 years old to participate in work-based learning experiences. The program will encourage employers by offering tax and insurance incentives to hire students in career-technical education



programs. This bill also allows school districts to offer driver's education courses and to give graduation credit for completion. By enabling students to safely get hands-on experiences at younger ages, schools and businesses can help students identify what they want to do in life and businesses gain access to bright young talent.
