If you are a probation officer, court bailiff or tactical medic, this class is for you!

Join Greg Perry, 2019 Ohio Distinguished Law Enforcement Trainer, May 15-19, 2023 from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. daily for the **OPOTA 40-Hour Court Officer Basic Training**.

This class is designed to comply with Ohio Administrative Code 109:2 and provides the state-mandated training required for court officers and tactical medics to carry firearms on duty. However, we cover much more than the state requires with a heavy emphasis on: Mindset and Personal Protection, the 4 Cardinal Rules of Gun Safety, the 5 Color Codes of Awareness, the Law of Deadly Force and Self-Defense, Marksmanship Fundamental, Gun Handling Skills, Tactics, Malfunctions, Movement, Ground Techniques, Use of Cover, Vehicles, Room Clearing, and much more.

New TechCred Application Round has opened!

TechCred has opened its 19th round in March. Through 17 rounds, 2,173 Ohio employers have been approved for funding through the TechCred program, supporting the earning of 57,233 tech-focused credentials by employees. Results of the January round will be announced soon.

The program helps businesses address their workforce needs by upskilling current and prospective employees. Businesses of all sizes, from any industry, are eligible for up to \$30,000 per round and up to \$180,000 per vear.
