

Student Right to Know – Completion and Graduation Rates

STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW, SEC. 485(A) OF THE HEA, 34 CFR 668.45

The Student Right-to-Know Act requires schools to disclose completion or graduation rates and, if applicable, transfer out rates for a specific cohort of the general student body. The cohort includes first-time, full-time certificate or degree-seeking undergraduate students entering MTC in the cohort year. A student is counted as “completing” or “graduating” if the student earns a degree or certificate within 150 percent of normal time for the student's program.

Cohort	Graduation Rate
Fall 2006	23%
