2 Are you currently employed as a Medical Assistant performing both clinical and administrative duties for a minimum of 5 out of the past 7 years? **If yes, you qualify!**

ABOUT THE COURSE AND THE BENEFITS TO YOU:

The Marion Technical College RMA Review course meets 3 hours once a week to review the materials covered on the AMT certification exam. This 3 credit-hour course places special emphasis on administrative and clinical procedures, medical terminology, and Anatomy and Physiology.

Upon successful completion of the AMT exam you will be credentialed as a Registered Medical Assistant (RMA).
