

Marion Technical College Drive-Thru Celebration

On Friday, May 14, Marion Technical College will hold a drive-thru diploma pick-up Graduation celebration from 5:00 to 7:00 pm. The celebration will air LIVE on 1490 WMRN-AM radio station as well as streamed live on WMFD.com and also on WMFD Facebook. - We are allowing only one car per graduate. You are encouraged to wear your cap and gown. Please consider decorating your caps and your vehicle!
- Arrival time can be anywhere between 5:00 – 7:00pm. There is no predetermined order.
- Vehicles will enter off University Drive (at the back of the campus). We will escort you into Parking Lot #3, to check in with a member from of the Graduation Planning Team, who will hand you a Graduate card containing your name and other information. PLEASE DO NOT LOSE THIS CARD. There will be several security officers and college volunteers helping direct the flow of traffic.
- Once you have checked in, you will then proceed to the route (SEE BELOW). When you approach the second roundabout (at the entrance to MTC), you will be greeted and asked for the Graduate card. At that time, Dr. Amy Adams will announce your name, degree and any honors awarded live on the radio. Please have your radio set to 1490 WMRN AM.
- Next, Dr. Ryan McCall, our President, will hand each graduate their diploma (if you were a Summer or Fall 2020 graduate you will not receive a diploma but will be handed a blank diploma cover to use for pictures). Graduates and family members should remain in their vehicles at this point.
- Once you have received your diploma, please proceed out of the roundabout and turn right moving on to Parking Lot #5 (the student parking lot) for the opportunity for photos taken by Heflin Photography. There is no initial cost to have the photos taken; however, they will be uploaded to the photographer's website where you are will be able to order and pay for prints if desired. If students do not wish to have their photos taken, they can simply proceed to the exit lane by still going to parking lot 5. You will be directed out by a volunteer.
- The buildings will not be open to the public and therefore, restrooms will not be available so please plan accordingly.


